a Word From Our Pastor

LAST WORDS

He Has Risen!!

Pr has he? I mean, yes, Jesus is resurrected on Easter Sunday, after all that is what Easter is about. However, I believe that this newsletter will be out before Easter Sunday and saying this just feels ... not quite right. I want to save it for when I can hear your voices chorus back, "He has risen, indeed!" (note – on Easter Sunday I will expect to hear those words said back to me!)

Instead of Easter, I will speak of Maundy Thursday. Let me throw in a quick advertisement for the service.... (woman with graying hair in red shirt) I hope to see you at our Maundy Thursday service at Trinity UMC on Thursday, March 28th, at 5:30. It will be held in the Family Center, and will be a family style meal of Tacos, along with the Word of God. Please RSVP by TEXT @ 989-390-1835 by Tuesday, or call, to let us know how many will be attending. We don't want to come up short on food!

John 13:34-35 "A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another."

Fesus Christ, after he knelt down upon his knees and washed all of the disciples' feet clean of dirt, dung, and grime, at what would be their last meal together, their Passover meal, proclaims to the disciples, those words above, in red. After this meal, Jesus and his disciples went to the Garden of Gethsemane where Jesus was kissed by Judas, later arrested, then crucified the following morning. So, this would have been Thursday evening at what we now refer to as Maundy Thursday, or Holy Thursday. These words in red are very important, as they are the very basis of what Maundy Thursday is about. Maundy comes from the Latin word mandatum, or

mandate. These words in red are not spoken as an option, or something they should do, but something they are commanded to do by Jesus. A mandate. Love one another. As I have loved you so you MUST love one another. (My capitalization, not the Bible.)

Let us be clear about this. These words were some of the last words that Jesus spoke to his disciples. His last words. When he could have said anything at all, or better yet, when the time had come to give the disciples the most important information they needed to know, he commanded them to love one another. And specifically, as Jesus loved them. That's important to note. There is no more powerful love than the love of God. Why? Well, the next sentence explains why. By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another." But that is not the "why" I am asking about because this love that Jesus speaks of (often and with utmost importance) is not just about our outward showing to others that we are followers of Christ. It goes deeper than that. It is a personal thing. It is a deep down inside us and how we love Jesus kind of thing. It is about us and who we are on the inside. Why did Jesus command us to love and to love one another? What is it about His love that he wants us to understand?

ou may be thinking that I am going to tell you why.... but I am not going to. That, my friend, is a question that you need to figure out yourself.

John 13:34 "A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another."
